Continuing Education (CE)

- All Jones Institute courses are 20 hours.
- Jones Institute does not allow partial attendance at any course. A registrant must complete the full 20 hours of the course to receive a completion certificate for that course. – No exceptions.
- Jones Institute applies for CE approval with the State Physical Therapy Board in the state where the course is held. We submit our application for boards that require the educational provider to get approval before the course begins. We do not apply with state boards that do not require the provider to have approval.
- If you are attending a course and hold a license outside of the state where the course is held, please check with your state licensing board for their CE requirements on courses out of state.

Upon approval from the state board CE approval information will be printed on the bottom of each completion certificate.

- Jones Institute has been teaching across the U.S. for over 30 years and has always been given CE approval for all courses.
- A Jones Institute course completion certificate may be filed by the therapist with any state board for CE credit however, if you are attending and hold your license outside of the state where the course is held, please check with your state licensing board for their CE requirements on courses out of state.

- Jones Institute is an NCBTMB provider.
- The Jones Institute Certification Test does not qualify for CE's. It is a test.
